## LANGUAGE TRAINING OF HIGHER EDUCATION APPLICANTS OF THE MINISTRY OF INTERNAL AFFAIRS OF UKRAINE

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The work of the basics of language education of future employees is mainly carried out by state administrative institutions. Separation of research methods, traditions, the correlation of this topic is that language plays a big role in government management. The internal affairs authorities have always supported the people of the country, and of course they can do this through language. People who work in the Ministry of Internal Affairs must have linguistic literacy in order to analyze the interests of citizens and the country. Of course, they are in the interests of citizens, but sometimes national interests prevail. This can cause great damage to the country. The interests of the country itself are society. Thanks to language, you can quickly gather information. To a certain extent, social justice and equality can be quickly and correctly restored. Therefore, language is an important factor that we must consider.

The purpose of the study: to analyze how different methods of training young employees of the Ministry of Internal Affairs of Ukraine determine their traditions, principles and perspectives.

Research topic: Principles and customs of law enforcement agencies.

Show main materials. In the modern world, government in the form of democratic forms has a positive effect on society and society, such as citizens and citizens who can realize their interests in the language of lawyers. As a rule, the interests of most people are the same, so civil society was created to improve each other, national laws and moral bonds.

In order to achieve the possibility of being protected, law enforcement agencies are engaged in the protection of the rights and freedoms of a person. These rights and freedoms can maintain order in society and acquaint them with the basic principles of law enforcement activities, with the specific conditions for the training of law enforcement agencies, i.e., the methodology of their training. The main goal of the higher educational institution of the Ministry of Internal Affairs of Ukraine is professional socialization. In other words, they must create real professionals.

This goal is formed through the integration of reforms, authorities with the help of European standards. Therefore, the police should have independence in their activities (of course, on the basis of standardized legal actions), which will improve the process and freedom of protection of citizens' rights.

Therefore, the police have always used communication methods and expanded these methods according to certain principles to carry out appropriate socialization, such as morals and moral principles.

This is a combination of main and auxiliary factors that have a very positive effect on the performance of the professional duties of a police officer. During the training of students, teachers will immediately provide them with theoretical knowledge. It is believed that professional language training in the Ukrainian system can be divided into: and public, in other words, collective communication between colleagues, that is, communication between police statutes, communication between the public, social police regulation, intersocial, intersocial communication is one of the examples of special training of students. Teachers of higher education institutions try to create conditions so that students can continue to use the acquired knowledge in their courses.

Through the distortion of laws, facts, warnings, etc. In the minds of students - this is the idea of the right actions, in other words, professional skills, these skills help to quickly analyze different ways of solving or solving problems with the help of language, information. Therefore, teachers and students, together with the mentioned two main functions (communication and communication), form a certain strategy for solving problems. People pay a lot of attention to the study of the country and international languages. This is due to the fact that any country tries to develop its field of tourism, which usually leads to a conflict between foreigners and citizens of the country. According to Article 26 of the Constitution of Ukraine, foreigners and foreigners have the same rights and duties, therefore the rights of foreigners should also be protected by the police and pay great attention to the process of communicating with foreigners in foreign languages [2].

As mentioned above, Ukraine explains that European value is given to foreigners in all spheres of public life, which allows students to develop their cultural literacy and have confidence in fulfilling their professional duties. This is what language training is aimed at in order to increase the level of education of a person[3]. It is very useful for post-socialist

countries - the language of education, because it completely rejected the old system of police training, based on the experience of military schools.

Nowadays, disciplinary training is certainly present, but it is combined with a language that allows students to feel more confident when performing or practicing professional duties.

As for these principles, they are all provided by the "National Police" of the legislation of Ukraine, about which: the rule of law, respect for human rights and freedoms, legality, openness and transparency, political neutrality, interaction with the population and population with the population are the basis of interactive partnership, etc [4]. The above principles are implanted in the minds of students, allowing them to automatically explain their behavior according to this law. In other words, these principles are based on moral norms. In terms of tradition, students attended various events to increase the level of culture and socialization. These are usually collective events, so traditions can be attributed to the celebration of national holidays. There are also traditional communication processes between different HEIs that enable all such activities.

The perspective is to improve the trust of the country's population, improve communication with European colleagues, reduce negative social processes, improve culture and legal education.

Thus, each higher education institution of internal affairs of Ukraine has specific training conditions, which means that each has its own professional duties that prepare trainees. As a rule, teachers try to create such conditions in the educational process so that students can continue to use their skills. They can do this through various discussions and scientific conferences. Students can show their analytical skills. Teachers combine communicative and cumulative functions. It should also be noted that students study the language according to the main disciplines.

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
