CURRENT ISSUES OF INTERNATIONAL POLICE COOPERATION

Most of the legislation of a particular state is formed on the basis of or with the borrowing of generally recognized international standards. Because of this, international cooperation in the field of policing is covering more and more territories, striving for development and mutual assistance. The strengthening of international cooperation is greatly influenced by the observance of international human rights norms, the principle of legality, and the sovereignty of countries. By examining the legal components in the field of international police cooperation, it is possible to outline actions that contribute to the development of the following areas: strengthening mutual assistance and law enforcement; a simplified way of exchanging relevant information; and mutual cooperation in the professional training of police officers.

In my opinion, international police cooperation can be described as the combined activities of police/law enforcement officers from other countries or international organisations. For example, the Law of Ukraine "On the

National Police" contains Article 4 on international police cooperation, which states that relations in the areas of police activity with the relevant authorities of other states and international organisations are based on international treaties, as well as on the constituent acts and rules of international organisations of which Ukraine is a member [1].

The Department of International Police Cooperation is a structural unit of the National Police of Ukraine, whose activities are directly carried out in close cooperation between the International Criminal Police Organisation INTERPOL and Europol. Interpol is an international organisation that facilitates the search for a person and assists police authorities in this. According to Article 2 of the Charter of the International Criminal Police Organisation - INTERPOL, its objectives are:

- (1) to provide for and maintain the widest possible mutual assistance between all criminal police authorities within the limits of the laws of different countries and in the spirit of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights;
- (2) to establish and develop all institutions that can effectively contribute to the prevention and suppression of common criminal offences [2].

The highest body in this organisation is the General Assembly. This body determines the basic principles of the organisation's work, outlines the work plan for the year, and is elected by other bodies of the organisation. Interpol officers do not have the right to arrest people or carry weapons on their own.

A. Solonar points out that international police cooperation is based on international treaties. constituent acts and rules of international organisations of which Ukraine is a member [3, p. 157]. Based on the review of the law enforcement base and police practice, the following forms of international police cooperation can be identified: development, conclusion of international agreements and ensuring their implementation, execution of requests for legal assistance, information interaction, making requests and fulfilling such requests, acceptance and transfer of persons in custody at the state border of Ukraine or abroad [3, p. 158]. All police agencies adhere to these forms, as they help to achieve one of the main goals of international cooperation - maintaining law and order with the help of available police tools. The existing forms of cooperation facilitate the work of not only the police authorities of Ukraine, but also law enforcement agencies of other countries. The process of providing

information upon request should be carried out confidentially, without disclosing the details of requests from international organisations.

Thus, it can be concluded that international cooperation is an important aspect of police work and development. International police cooperation can be carried out in the following areas: combating crime, ensuring peace and security, and training police personnel through the exchange of experience. Cooperation between police officers from different countries allows them not only to help each other, but also to gain new knowledge, skills and practice.
